June 10, 1949 - November 29, 2025

Lieutenant Bob Moore, 76, passed away on November 29, 2025, in Columbus. Bob was born on June 10, 1949, in Andalusia, Alabama, to the late Edward Moore and Mary Wright.

Bob was a graduate of Lee High School in Columbus, Mississippi, and attended Mississippi State University before answering the call of duty. He was drafted into the United States Army during the Vietnam War, marking the beginning of over 20 years of dedicated military service. During his time in the Army, Bob served with distinction as a Green Beret and as a member of the Airborne Division.

Following his military service, Bob continued his life of service in law enforcement. For more than four decades, he wore his badge with honor and pride as a Lieutenant with the West Point Police Department. His career was defined by an unwavering commitment to safety and justice. Over his 40-year tenure, Bob became a mentor to many young officers and a trusted protector of the West Point community. While he was a dedicated professional, he was also beloved by his colleagues for his sense of humor. Bob was known around the station for his jokes and his legendary practical jokes, bringing laughter to those he worked alongside.

Beyond his professional life, Bob was a loving husband and a caring father

who prioritized his family above all else. He was a true outdoorsman who found his greatest joy in nature. Whether he was hunting, fishing, or shooting, he was happiest when he was outside. He was an active and longtime member of the Lowndes County Wildlife Federation Hunting Club and cherished every moment spent with his loved ones.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother-in-law, Robert Lee Jeffcoat.
