Mr. Samuel “Boyd” Butler, 76, passed away on September 15, 2024, at North Mississippi Medical Center in West Point. Boyd was born on June 13, 1948, in West Point, to the late Samuel Lafayette Butler and Sara Jordan “Bitsy” Weaver. Boyd graduated from West Point High School in 1966. He attended Northeast Mississippi Junior College in Booneville and received an Associate's Degree from East Mississippi Junior College. Boyd was a Veteran of the United States Army, serving during the Vietnam War in Okinawa, Japan. He, then, served his country with the Mississippi Army National Guard where he was a Staff Sergeant with the 223rd Engineering Battalion in West Point. He loved playing golf, baseball, and softball.
