November 9, 1950 - January 30, 2025

Clarence Boyd “C.B.” Thompson, Jr., 74, of West Point, passed away peacefully on Thursday, January 30, 2025, at his home surrounded by his family following an extended illness.

C.B. was born November 9, 1950, in Alexandria, Virginia, the son of the late Clarence Boyd and Ann Rhea Thompson. He attended West Point City Schools before entering the United States Army where he served as a Military Policeman in Korea. After returning from Korea, he worked as a mechanic at Jameson Ford Motor Company. He later worked at Clark Motor Company and Larry White Chevrolet before starting his own business. He owned and operated Thompson Auto Repair and C & G Towing for more than 40 years where he was well known for his expertise in mechanics and building engines. He was an avid NASCAR fan and longtime collector of Dale Earnhardt, Sr., and Dale Earnhardt, Jr., memorabilia. He was a member of Calvary Baptist Church. Before his health would no longer allow it, he enjoyed meeting his friends for coffee every morning.

C.B. married the love of his life, Patricia Vest Thompson, on October 10, 1969.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by one sister, Bettye Jean Wingo and his brother, Thomas F. Thompson.

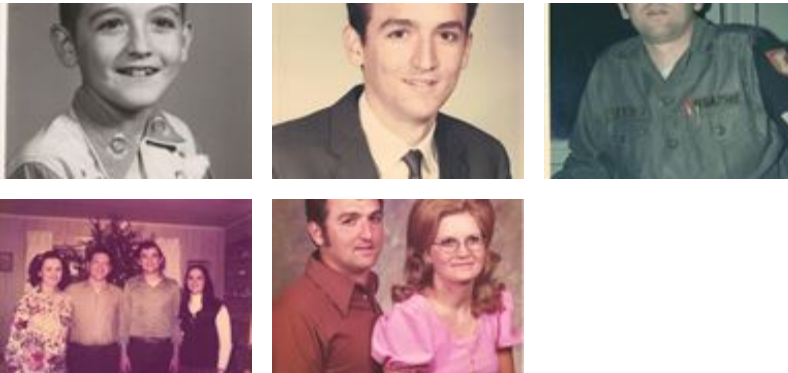
