Mr. Douglas Lamar Dendy, 80, passed away on May 3, 2020 at Diversicare in Eupora. Lamar was born on April 3, 1940, in Chickasaw County, the son of the late Ellis Adron and Jewel Lorene Dendy. He was a Veteran of the United States Army, where he was a truck mechanic. He was a Maintenance Superintendent at Bryan Foods for 40 years. He was a member of Pine Bluff Baptist Church where he served as a Deacon and in multiple other capacities. He was very proud of his military service and his years at Bryan Foods.
