Mr. Durwood Ware, 75, passed away on February 24, 2024, at his home in West Point. Mr. Emmett Durwood Ware was born November 6, 1948, in West Point, the son of the late George W. "Dub" and Vera Eloise Marshall Ware. Mr. Durwood, as he was affectionately called, was a graduate of West Point High School Class of 1966. Upon graduation, Mr. Durwood joined the United States Navy and served our country during the Vietnam War. 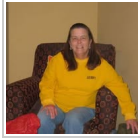
