Mrs. Elizabeth Davis Edwards, 96, passed away on March 16, 2017, at Dugan Memorial Home in West Point. Mrs. Elizabeth was born on September 2, 1920, in the Cairo Community of Clay County, the daughter of the late Thomas Jefferson and Estelle Gordon Davis. Mrs. Elizabeth lived in Clay County her entire life. Mrs. Elizabeth was a Secretary at Babcock and Wilcox for 28 years, having worked from 1957-1985. Mrs. Elizabeth was a member of Siloam Baptist Church. Mrs. Elizabeth was a member of United Daughters of the Confederacy, where she was the State President from 1988-1990. Mrs. Elizabeth was a member of the Clay County Art Club where she was an avid and accomplished artist. Mrs. Elizabeth was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, sister and friend. Mrs. Elizabeth married John Marion "Shine" Edwards on November 30, 1940 in the Cairo Community and he preceded her in death on October 26, 1953. 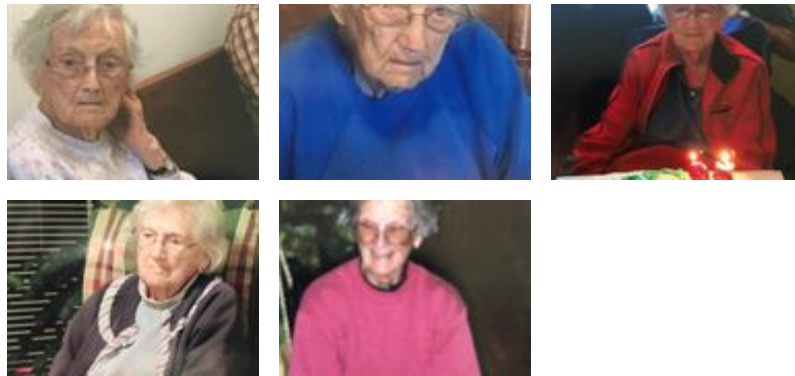
