Mr. Elmon Aron Walls, 91, died Sunday, January 14th, at his home in West Point, Mississippi. He was born April 30th, 1926 in Vardaman, Mississippi, the sixth child of Hosea Littleton Walls and Annie Lee Vanlandingham Walls. He crafted beautiful antique reproduction pieces that serve as an emblem of his excellent skills.

He was preceded in death by his parents Hosea and Annie Walls; his son, Randy Walls; his son-in-law, Sam T. Pilkinton III; four sisters, Margaret, Etoile , Orene, and Norma; three brothers, L.V. (Bill), Howard , and Harold; two nephews, Eric and Michael; and one niece, Joan. He loved his family immensely and missed those who preceded him.
