Mr. Gene A. Grubbs, 74, passed away on November 8, 2014 at his residence in Prairie. Mr. Gene was born March 24, 1940, in Union County, the son of the late James Ross and Edith Lorraine Hall Grubbs. He was a Civil Engineer, having worked as an Estimator with CECO in Columbus for 37 years. He was a member of Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church, where he was the Treasurer since 1970. He was also the longtime Treasurer of the Houston Parrish of the United Methodist Church. He was a Gideon and a diligent volunteer with the Project Homestead Food Pantry. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather, brother, brother-in-law and friend. He married Kitty Baker on December 19, 1965, at the Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother: Harold Grubbs.
