Hubert Lamar Watson, I, 85 passed away on April 21, 2024, at his daughter's residence in Oktibbeha County. He was born on August 3, 1938, in the Pheba community of Clay County, the son of the late Thurman Allen Watson and the late Lillian Felder Watson. Following graduation from West Point High School, Hubert enlisted in the Army National Guard as a member of the 223rd Engineering Battalion where he received recognition as Most Outstanding Soldier. After completing his military service, he then continued his education attending East Mississippi Junior College, Northeast Mississippi Community College, and Mississippi State University. Hubert was a hard worker and he held many positions of employment over the years, which included P.I.
