Mr. James Walter Fowler, 81, passed away on December 8, 2016, at North Mississippi Medical Center in Tupelo. Mr. James was born January 14, 1935, in Indianola, the son of the late John Edward and Mary Jane Otts Fowler. He was an United States Army Veteran. Mr. James was a member of West End Baptist Church in West Point. He enjoyed birdwatching and watching western movies. He began working with the West Point Police Department in 1960, where he worked his way up through the department, retiring in 1996 after 36 years as the Assistant Police Chief. He married Catherine Maudine Morrow on February 18, 1956, in West Point and they were married for 60 years. Mr. James was a loving husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother and friend.
