Mr. James Roland Lyon, 86, passed away on September 22, 2017, at North Mississippi Medical Center in Tupelo. Mr. James Roland Lyon was born April 27, 1931, in Cedar Bluff, the son of the late George Wilbur and Cora Lee Davis Lyon. Mr. Roland was an United States Army Veteran. He was a retired Rural Mail Carrier with the United States Postal Service working out of the Cedar Bluff Post Office. Mr. Roland was an avid and accomplished woodworker and carpenter that enjoyed making clocks. He was a Master Mason serving with the Pheba Masonic Lodge. Mr. Roland was a lifelong loyal and faithful member of Cedar Bluff Baptist Church where he served in many capacities including Trustee, Chairman of the Deacons, Treasurer, and Sunday School Teacher. 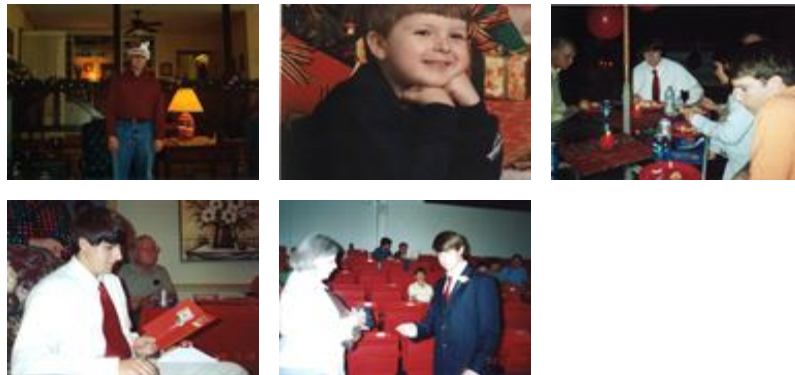
