Mr. Jerald L. "Jerry" Smith, 76, passed away on Wednesday, July 29, 2015, at his home in West Point. He held his Bachelor's Degree from Mississippi State University and was a Veteran of the United States Army. He was a cattleman that raised beef cattle. He owned and operated his trucking company.
