Mr. Joe Larry Arick, 78, passed away on March 4, 2024, at North Mississippi Medical Center, Tupelo, MS. Joe was born on May 24, 1945 in Pheba, MS. He was the son of the late Everett and Annie Laura McCluskey Arick.

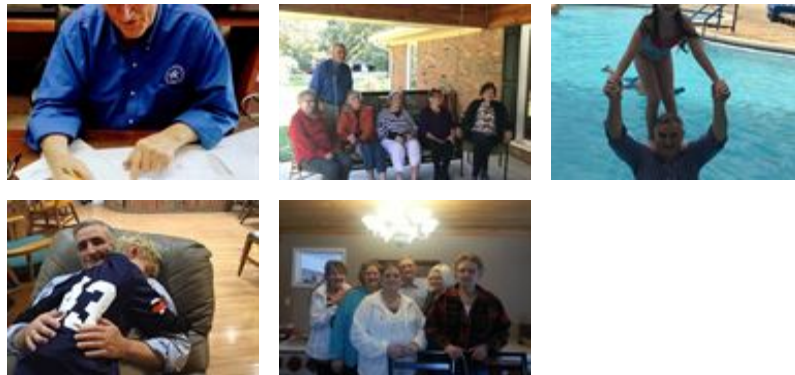
