Mr. Joe W. Jackson, 80, passed away on March 4, 2016, at North Mississippi Medical Center in West Point. Mr. Joe was born September 10, 1935, in Prairie, the son of the late John William and Iva Lee Griggs Jackson. Mr. Joe owned and operated Joe's Garage for a number of years, but Mr. Joe's real passion was for music. He was an avid and accomplished musician, who could not only sing, but play any instrument handed to him. Through the years he played in several bands including his own, Joe Jackson and the Untouchables. His love of music was very much a part of his life, and on July 30, 2008, he was inducted into the Rockabilly Hall of Fame in Nashville, TN. He attended both Prairie Baptist Church and Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church. In addition to the love of music, he was a loving husband, father, grandfather, great grandfather, brother, uncle, and friend. He married Betty Sue Ward Jackson on May 5, 1958, in Columbus and she passed away January 18, 2009.
