



## Miss Lillian Frances Boyd

September 30, 1928 - March 29, 2024

Miss Lillian Frances Boyd passed away on Friday, March 29, 2024, at North Mississippi Medical Center in West Point. Lillian was born on September 30, 1928, in Oakville, Tennessee, to the late John Calvin and Jewell Wilson Boyd. She graduated from Whitehaven High School in Memphis, Tennessee. She was an active member of Oakville United Methodist Church until moving to Bartlett, Tennessee, in 1962. After moving her membership to Bartlett United Methodist Church, she became an active member in the Fidelity Sunday School Class, Senior Adult Fellowship, and several church committees. Lillian retired as Civilian Personnel and Administration Department Supervisor with the Naval Air Technical Training Center in Millington, Tennessee. During her 40-year career with Federal Service, she earned the Meritorious Civilian Service, Superior Civilian Service, and Career Service Awards. In 2001, she moved to her retirement home in Mantee, and became active in Sunday School, missions, and senior adult activities at Mantee Baptist Church. Lillian enjoyed gardening, especially her vegetable and daylily beds, needlework, traveling with her sister throughout North America, the Caribbean, and Europe. She was an avid reader of history, enjoyed crocheting caps for missions, and was the Boyd family historian.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her brother, John Wilson Boyd, and her sister, Patty Sue Boyd.
