Mrs. Martha Jo Brand, 78, passed away on December 22, 2023, at North Mississippi Medical Center in West Point. Martha Jo was born on July 10, 1945, in West Point, the daughter of the late John A. and Annie Catherine Hazlewood Jasper.

She spent her childhood on the family farm and loved all animals and was a quite a horseman. She married Paul "Bert" Brand on September 5, 1968, in West Point and together they shared over 54 years. He predeceased her on May 17, 2023. She graduated from Mississippi State University in 1967, with a degree in Business Administration. She began her working career with the Mississippi Department of Human Services as a welfare visitor in West Chickasaw County and was quickly promoted to social worker. She later transferred to the Clay County office in 1971, becoming an eligibility worker. She was promoted to Supervisor in 1975 and in 1988, she was named Clay County Director of Human Services. After 45 years of serving the community, she retired on June 30, 2011. She served others all of her life and she loved her family with all of her heart. Her door and heart was always open to anyone in need. Taking care of those in need and her family is how she fulfilled her life and found her greatest joy. In addition to her parents and husband, Martha Jo was preceded in death by a step-son, Robert Brand.

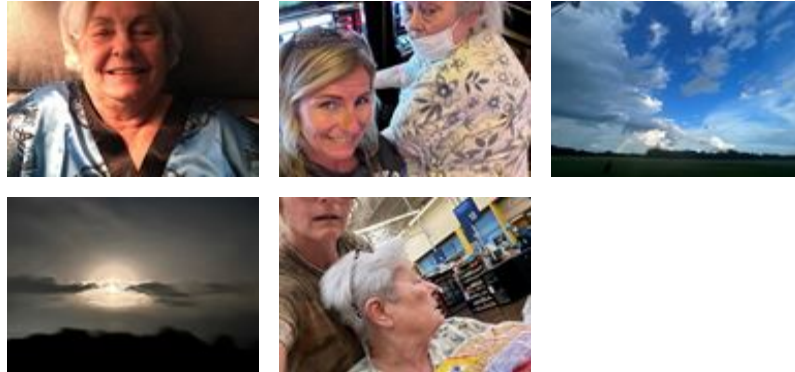
