Mary Charlene Pruett, 91, passed away on Sunday, November 14, 2021. Charlene was born on January 15, 1930 in McCool, to Charles and Lula Rook. Charlene was a lifelong resident of West Point, where she married the love of her life, Sammie on October 24, 1947. She served in many capacities including Knickerbocker, Chandler Insurance, and ultimately for Babcock and Wilcox for 27 years until she retired.
