Sam Hollingsworth, 71, passed away, on Wednesday, October 31, 2012 at his home, in West Pont. Sam Alford Hollingsworth was born October 4, 1941 to Allie Mae Hollis Reid and the late William Aaron Hollingsworth. He worked under Sheriff Virgil Middleton as a deputy before becoming a Wildlife Conservation Officer for the State of Mississippi retiring in 1996. Sam was a member of Old Aberdeen Road Church of Christ. He was a Veteran of the Mississippi National Guard serving during the Cuban Crisis. Sam Alford Hollingsworth married Jimmy Dell Thompson Hollingsworth January 5, 1963, in West Point.
