She was a graduate of Draughn Business College and graduated M.U.W. with a double major in Business and Pyscology. She received her Master's Degree from the College of Psychology at Liberty University with an emphasis in Christian Family Counseling. Mrs. Westbrook was past Regent of the Horseshoe Robertson Chapter of the D. A. R. She was queen mother of the local chapter Red Hat Society. She was a member of First United Methodist Church where she taught Sunday School and was member of Lochie Millard Circle and had just last hosted the circle with a breakfast last December. She was a member of the Chancel Choir and later the Singspirations Senior Choir. She loved all three of her grandchildren, as well enjoying sewing, collecting music boxes, playing tennis, traveling, target shooting, canoeing, camping and cooking for her family. She had traveled abroad to Paris and enjoyed several cruise ship tours. One of the highlights of her travel was to make a Western Tour by Rail and visiting along the way with her brother in Utah.
