Mr. O. M. Johnson, 83, passed away on September 5, 2023, at North Mississippi Medical Center in West Point. Mr. Otis Morrell "O. M." Johnson was born on December 16, 1939, in Choctaw County, to the late Odie Lee and Hazel Shurden Johnson. Having lost his mother as a toddler, his dad then married Ethel Sanders Johnson. Mr. O. M. founded Johnson Timber Company in the 1960's. He was an avid outdoorsman and woodworker, having a specialty in ornate wood molding. He enjoyed raising catfish and carrying people fishing. He was a member of Harmon Lake Hunting Club. He was a faithful member of Mhoon Valley Church of Christ, where he helped build the church from trees that were made into logs for building. He served as the Bishop of the church until his declining health. He was known as a "tough man", but was affectionately known by his family as a loving, husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother, and friend.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two sisters, Ann Sellars and Ruth Foreman and one brother, Everette Yeatman.

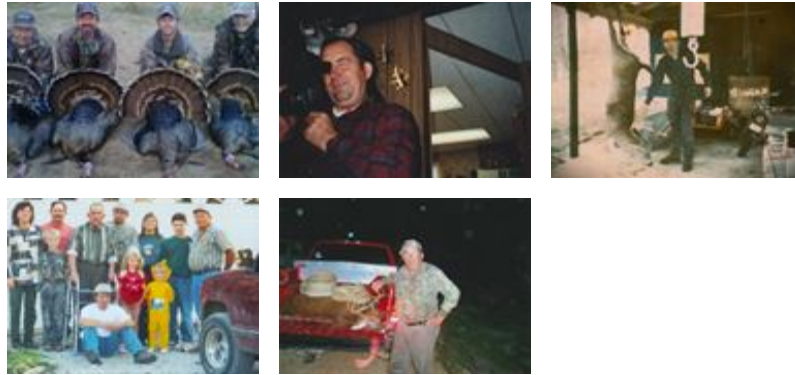
