



Mrs. Perval Sanders Hunt

October 7, 1926 - November 12, 2023

Mrs. Perval Sanders Hunt, 97, passed away on November 12, 2023, at Oceans Hospital in Tupelo. Perval Hunt was born Perval Estelle Sanders, on October 7, 1926, in rural Oktibbeha County, near Sturgis, to the late William Christopher and Ethel Oliver Sanders. She spent her school years during the worst of the Great Depression. On April 24, 1943, at the age of 16, she married her sweetheart, Garland Hunt. Three months after her wedding, her new husband enlisted in the United States Navy. While her husband was serving in the South Pacific, she gave birth to their first child. With the war behind them, Perval was a homemaker and farmer's wife in Charleston and then Sturgis. Later she and her husband worked the night shift at The Cotton Mill in Starkville. In May of 1954, Perval and Garland moved their young daughter and son to West Point. She worked in the bacon department of Bryan Brothers in West Point and later at American Bosch in Columbus before becoming a stay-at-home mom and an avid gardener. After almost 79 years she was widowed, when Garland passed away on April 9, 2022. She was excitedly anticipating the birth of her third great-great-grandchild, which is due in April 2024.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by three sisters, Elsie Sanders, Arlin Starnes, and Irene Johnson, one brother, W. C. Sanders, Jr., a step-sister and several step-brothers.
