Mr. Robert Lewis Elliott, Sr., 92, passed away on January 24, 2016, at his residence in West Point. Mr. Robert was born January 2, 1924, in the Black Hawk Community of Carroll County the son of the late Sam Eugene and Zola Claire Tate Elliott. He was a 1942 Graduate of Black Hawk High School where he was Salutatorian of his class. He was an United States Army Air Corp Veteran of World War II. He was a member of Calvary Baptist Church in West Point. He was a Foreman of the Metal Working Section of the 14th Civil Engineering Squadron at Columbus Air Force Base, retiring after 35 years.
